## CFT 100-Fundamentals of Woodworking

**CFT 100 (Fundamentals of Woodworking) is a prerequisite class for all other classes in the CFT program.**

The Cabinet & Furniture Technology Program at Palomar is excited to announce we have opened our Brand New Facility. We have 4 newly expanded Classrooms, 3 state of the art labs with over \$275,000 of new machinery, and \$600,000 spent on new exhaust and compressed air systems. We finally have our first piece of CNC Equipment - a new Haas VF-3 CNC Router. Even our shop stools (with cushioned backs) are brand new.

### Class Project

This is a class where the beginner and the long-term woodworker work side by side and each gain tremendously. CFT 100 (Fundamentals of Woodworking) is a prerequisite class for all other classes in the CFT program. The work is presented in such a way that it is easily understood by the novice. At the same time the experienced woodworker will learn new techniques and find that the work fills in all sorts of knowledge gaps that update and refresh their skills. You will be introduced to many types of woodworking equipment (Tablesaw, Jointer, Planer, Router, and Bandsaws to name a few) and learn how to use each of them efficiently and safely. Each student will use their new skills to construct a clock. 4 clock plans are offered to choose from or if you are more experienced you may wish to design your own clock that meets with the class project criteria. The new skills that you learn in this process will make your transition into other classes easier. This class is offered each Fall & Spring semester.

### QUALIFYING FOR ENROLLMENT

Palomar College has a fully automated registration system. Students may apply and enroll online. To be eligible to enroll, students must have a current application on file. Returning students who have missed one semester must re-apply in order to receive an enrollment appointment. New Students who submit an application for fall by **May 12, 2016** will receive a priority online enrollment appointment. After **May 12, 2016**, apply online to receive a late enrollment appointment or access to the system for the open enrollment period that follows.

### USER ID AND PASSWORD

Once your application is processed, you will be issued a unique Palomar User ID number. To enroll, you will use your User ID number and a password. Your password can be up to 15 characters long. **Note:** If you forget your Palomar User ID and or password click on the link, Forgot my Student ID or password, located to the right of the ID input box on the “eServices” sign in page. Follow the online instructions to retrieve your ID and set a new password. For the added protection, you will be asked to choose a challenge question and provide a response. If you forget the response, call Admissions at 760-744-1150, ext. 2164 or visit Admissions to have your challenge question reset.

### ENROLLMENT APPOINTMENT

All class enrolments are processed using “Student Center”. Don’t worry if you miss your online appointment, you may enroll any time after your scheduled appointment. See the Admissions web page at [www.palomar.edu/admissions](http://www.palomar.edu/admissions) for instructions. The automated system operating hours are: Monday through Saturday, 6am to 11pm and Sunday 6am to 4pm. Call the Admissions office at 760-744-1150, ext. 2164 if you have any questions or email “admissions @palomar.edu”.

**The CFT 100 class has a Material Fee of is \$45.00. This fee must be paid at the Cashier office before the first class meeting.**

Students who enroll in classes must pay their fees promptly. Those who do not pay within 10 days of enrolling will be automatically dropped from classes.

Parking permits are required for all vehicles on District property 24 hours a day, seven days a week. **Fall Semester** permits may be purchased online from **June 2, 2016 thru August 14, 2016\*\*** with a credit card via the eServices link at [www.palomar.edu](http://www.palomar.edu). Once payment has been received and mailing address confirmed, the permit will be mailed to the student. Online purchase of permits will continue from **August 15, 2016 thru September 30, 2016\*\***, however those permits must be picked up by the student at the Police Department, located at the main entrance of the Parking Lot 1. Parking permits are available for purchase during normal school hours at the Cashier’s Office on the San Marcos campus and at the Escondido Center. **\*\* dates subject to change**

**There is no grace period for parking without a permit. Automobiles are \$40.00 One day permits are available from machines in the parking lots.**
