These small pieces of Pennsylvania furniture are extremely detailed in spite of their small size. This is a dovetailed cabinet with many drawers and secret compartments. These pieces, like most of the Pennsylvania Dutch furniture, are usually highly decorated.

Bob Stevenson will present the program showing the construction of the spice boxes also used as valuables chests. Bob will demonstrate the techniques used to decorate these pieces with line and berry inlay. He will discuss some of the other methods these German immigrants used to decorate their furniture. Remember, this is your exhibit and SDFWA's number one activity for the year. We need everyone to be involved in some way i.e. **ENTER, HELP WITH SET UP, VOLUNTEER AT THE EXHIBIT, HELP WITH TAKE DOWN.** We will provide great food and refreshments along with a generous number of free passes to the Fair just for a few hours of your time. Everyone gets two (2) passes for each shift you sign up for and four (4) passes a day for set up and take down volunteers. You also get passes for entering.

Here is how you sign up to volunteer in the 19<sup>th</sup> Century Chair Shop or to be a gallery floor walker.

## SIGNING UP

This year there will be several ways for DIW volunteers to sign up for the shifts wanted. In the past you could sign up at the General Meeting or you could call or email volunteer coordinator, Eric Lunde, with the date and times you wanted after getting the available dates and times from the SDFWA web site. These options are still available to you this year plus an addition of a New System to completely sign up online that we instituted last year...

## SIGNING UP ONLINE

To sign up online, go to the SDFWA web site. You will need your membership number from your membership card and your email address on file with the SDFWA (the one you used on your membership application). You will be asked for these items on the log-in page. If your member number and email matches our data base, you will be taken to a log-in page where you will create an ID and password for the web site. (This log-in ID and password will enable you to not only sign up for DIW volunteer shifts but will also enable you to access our new member's only section on our web site.). After you have logged-in, you will be taken to a volunteer sign up page where you and/or your spouse can reserve volunteer shifts in the shop or gallery.

Signups will start at the March 31<sup>st</sup> General meeting. Following that meeting, you can sign up online at SDFWA.org.

If the computer method or meeting sign ups are not possible for you, please call Eric Lunde at 858-487-7644 and leave your name, phone number and dates and times you desire and Eric will enable this for you depending on availability of the dates and times. If the times are already taken, Eric will call you back with alternatives.

David will gild with copper, silver, and Dutch metal leaf. In addition to demonstrating the traditional oil size method of gilding, he will also explore creative gilding techniques, such as the Japanese Notan method, of balancing positive and negative spaces. David will introduce students to the process of chemical patination. He will demonstrate various cold patina processes that students will learn working safely with mild acids. These are the same techniques that David uses on his award winning sculptures and vessels.
