## **December Program**

**This months program features Paul Schurch master of marquetry**

The Speaker for the December meeting is Paul Schurch, winner of best of show at 2002 San Diego County Fair. This lecture will cover veneering and marquetry, as practiced by Paul Schurch. The overview will cover the "Italian marquetry techniques, suppliers, examples and methods that he uses to create fine furniture in his shop. Since beginning his teaching, he has run a 2-4 year apprenticeship program for very selected individuals, taught seminars at the Marc Adams School of Woodworking and many guilds and clubs throughout the USA. This should be an informative talk about a unique style of decorative veneering that will inspire you to try this on your own. Paul will be bringing copies of his new video and companion book on marquetry included with the video/book will be a pair of V Tongs (veneer tweezers).
