Help, Help, DESIGN IN WOOD Still needs Your Help

The Design in Wood Exhibition at the Del Mar County Fair opens on June 7, 2014, and runs through July 6, 2014. In order to properly staff the exhibit, we desperately need more volunteers to walk the gallery floor and to help make chairs in the 19th Century workshop.

Absolutely no experience or special skills are needed for either of these positions. Whatever you need to know will be taught to you when you show up for your shift. There are several advantages to donating some of your time:

1. On the gallery floor you will have an opportunity to examine the entries, rather than just walk through quickly and glance at them. Fielding questions from the public could draw your attention to details that you might otherwise have overlooked. (Don't worry about questions to which you don't know the answers. You can always ask one of the staff members who will be nearby.)
2. Working in the chair shop allows you to work with hand tools that you might seldom use. (Don't worry if you don't know how because you will be given a short lesson and you will look like an expert to the public.)
3. For each shift you will receive two fair tickets. Sign up for more than one shift and you might collect enough tickets for you, your family, and your friends and neighbors. You will have to use one (1) ticket for yourself in order to enter the fairgrounds each time you come for your shift.
4. Sign up for closing shifts on the gallery floor and receive four (4) tickets per shift.
5. Volunteers can use an "employees only" gate and avoid the long lines at the main gate. Early entry to the fair allows you to visit some exhibits that are not yet open to the public.

September 12, 13, 14 2014

Christopher Schwarz is a long-time woodworker and writer who has spent the last 15 years encouraging woodworkers to embrace more handwork in their shops. He built his first workbench when he was 11 and was introduced to handwork when his family built its first house on an Arkansas farm



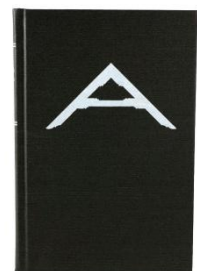
without electricity.

After formal training as a journalist at Northwestern University, Chris worked as a newspaperman by day and studied woodworking at night at the University of Kentucky. In 1996, he was hired as managing editor of Popular Woodworking, where he helped resuscitate the magazine and introduced more handwork into its pages. He eventually became editor and began writing books and teaching woodworking classes.

In 2007 he founded Lost Art Press LLC, a publishing company devoted to one thing: reviving handwork. By 2011, Lost Art Press had grown so much that Chris stepped down as editor of Popular Woodworking Magazine (he's now a contributing editor) to focus on his company full time and build furniture commissions. He's the author of several woodworking books, including "The Anarchist's Tool Chest," "Workbenches: From Design & Theory to Construction & Use," and "Campaign Furniture." He has also produced more than a dozen DVDs on handwork with Lie-Nielsen Toolworks and F+W Media Inc. He lives in Fort Mitchell, Ky., with his wife and two daughters.

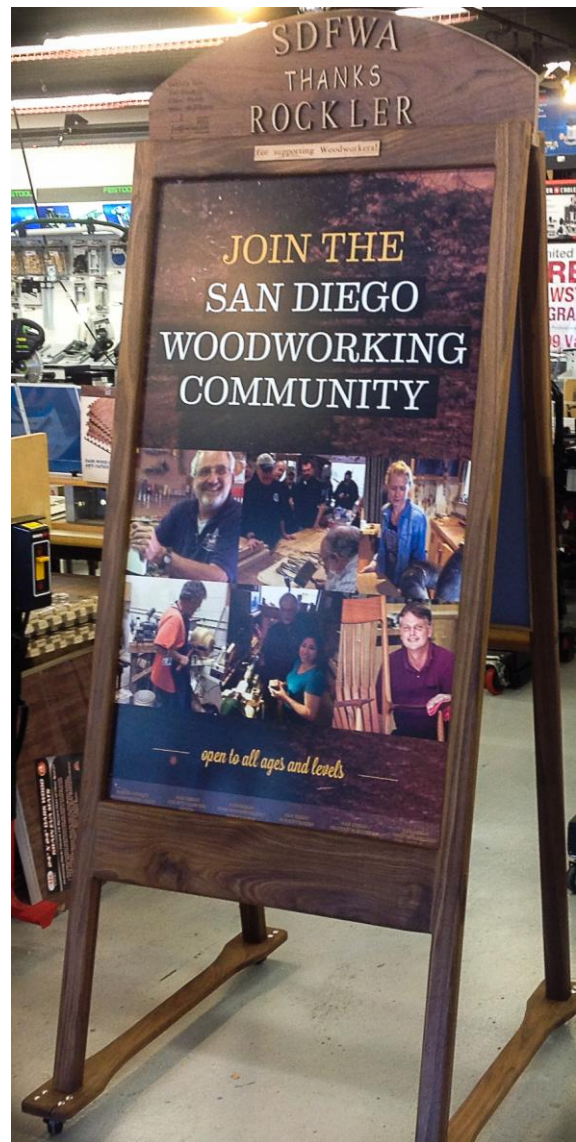
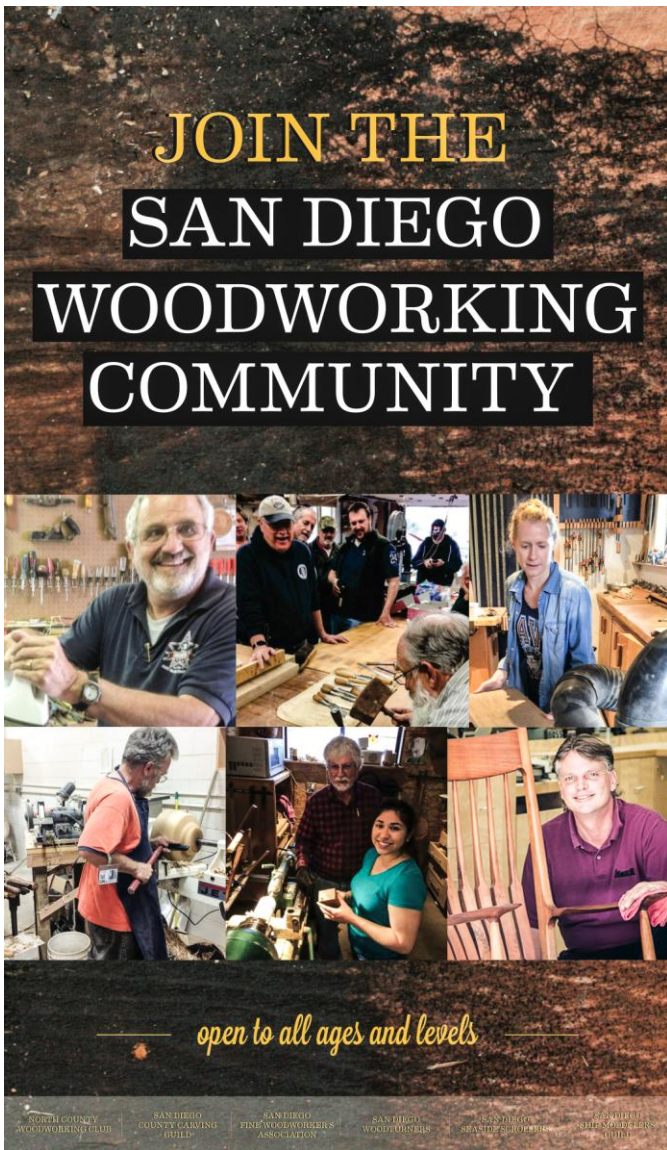
