Furniture Design

with Paul Schürch:

This one-hour presentation with Paul Schürch is about furniture design and the planning that goes into the construction of a project. Paul will cover some of the most important and valuable steps that you need to know before launching yourself into a new or complicated piece of furniture. Designing and drawing furniture can be tedious and overwhelming for most of us woodworkers, but should be an essential part of the process. Paul will talk about his own unique approach to designing furniture that he uses in his own pieces. He will present the concepts, drafting, mock-ups, and structural considerations in developing your design that he feels you should consider prior to making shavings in your shop.
