This month speaker is Jun Kwon. Jun has quite an impressive and diverse background. He started his career as a commercial furniture designer in Korea. Since coming to the states he has been invited to show his artwork at many museums and galleries throughout the US. One of the things that make Jun's skill set unique is that he has been a professor in both Interior design as well as studio furniture. He has also done work as an interior designer in San Diego and San Francisco as well. Most recently he has worked for UICA (Urban Institute for Contemporary Art) and Kendall College teaching Fine Art Furniture. Presently he is teaching at San Diego State.

Jun will be teaching us his technique for making band saw boxes. We will have a band saw setup and he will walk us through the process. Making these boxes is one of his specialties. The night will also include a slide show of his work. Jun's work is diverse as well. It ranges from Post Modern sculpture to traditional Korean Furniture with a twist.

Shop Tour

WHO: Tyme

WHAT: Tyme's home shop

WHEN: Saturday, December 6, 2008 9am to noon

WHERE: 6956 Wyoming Ave., La Mesa, CA 91942

Tyme's shop has to rate as nearly ideal for personal woodworking space, the kind of place most of us have dreamed about. It's in a separate recently-renovated building (an old baithouse for nearby Lake Murray) just outside the back door of his home. It has about 800 square feet and is filled with many custom-built work stations, each set up for efficiency and ease of use. Tyme's woodworking interests (aside from building shop installations!) are wide, including furniture, cabinetry and turning. His shop incorporates many self-designed, special features such as sound control, outstanding dust collection and electrical economy. The shop will be featured in an upcoming issue of Wood magazine. Expect an exceptional tour that could easily generate productive ideas for your own shop.

The location is not hard to find. From I-8 take the Lake Murray Blvd/70th St exit. COMING FROM THE WEST, turn left onto Lake Murray Blvd, cross the freeway and turn left onto Wisconsin Ave, but immediately bear right to get on Connecticut Ave. Proceed ahead (<0.5 mile) and take a right onto Wyoming. Tyme's is on the right (~0.25 mile) at the intersection with Oregon Ave. FROM THE EAST, the exit ramp drops you on Parkway Dr; turn left a short distance to Lake Murray Blvd., go across and take an immediate half-right onto Connecticut and proceed as above.

Parking is on the street. The customary appetizing morning refreshments will be available.
