September Program

The September program will feature Aaron Radelow talking about how he built the two extraordinary Boulle writing/reading tables featured on the cover of Woodworker West May-June 2010. They were also part of a recent Finewoodworking.com profile. <http://www.finewoodworking.com/Community/ArtistProfile.aspx?id=1406> These two tables are replicas made from pieces featured in the J. Paul Getty Museum. The originals were made for French King Louis XIV (circa 1670) and are covered with 3216 individual pieces of ivory and dyed blue cow horn along with sterling silver leaf. With the cooperation of the Getty, Aaron was able to measure and photograph the originals before beginning the replicas. For the program Aaron will show slides of building the pieces along with samples of the materials and how they are used in the process. He will also bring a chevalet cutting bench and demonstrate the cutting of the packets.
